Court summarizes the second superseding indictment. Witnesses names read to the jurors. Court continues instruction and questions the jurors.

Potential jurors acknowledge previous Court summary of the second superseding indictment. Court continues instruction and questions the jurors.

2:38 pm - Counsel for the government questions potential jurors.

Court continues instruction and questions the jurors.

5:05 pm - Counsel for the government questions potential jurors.

5:27 pm - Defense counsel questions potential jurors.

5:50 pm - Allowance of time given to counsel for review of juror questions and answers.

SIDEBAR 5:56 pm - Counsel execute both challenges for cause and peremptory challenges.
