BRIEFING**

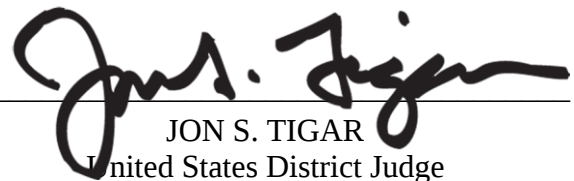

The Court has received Proposed Intervenor's request for clarification concerning the briefing schedule for the pending motion to intervene and for preliminary injunction, which requests the opportunity to file a reply brief in support of the motion for intervention. ECF No. 118. The Court has also received the Government's opposition. ECF No. 119.

Proposed Intervenor's October 26, 2020 reply brief fully addressed the issues raised in both their motion to intervene and their motion for preliminary injunction, including whether Proposed Intervenor satisfy Rule 24(a) or 24(b) as well as whether the Court has subject matter jurisdiction over Intervenor's claims, both for purposes of permitting intervention and for purposes of granting a preliminary injunction. Thus, the Court concludes that no further briefing is necessary or authorized.
