Ore Tenus Motion to Continue Trial and extend Motion's deadline by Defense. The Court grants the motion with no opposition from the Government.

Defense Counsel is to file a waiver of speedy trial through April 30, 2022.

After considering all the factors, including those set forth in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(B), and for the reasons stated on the record at the status conference, the Court finds that the ends of justice served by granting such a continuance outweigh the best interest of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. The Court, therefore, determines that the time from today 1/13/2022 until and including April 30, 2022 shall be "excludable time" pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h).
