PROCEEDINGS

Minute Entry for proceedings held before Judge Araceli Martínez-Olguín: Sentencing held on 5/13/2024 for Aaron Boren (4), Count 1 of the Information.

Defendant is committed to the Bureau of Prisons for a term of 12 months and 1 day to be served followed by 3 years of supervised release.

A special assessment fee of \$100.00 is imposed. Fine waived. Defendant shall pay restitution in an amount to be determined at a later date.

See Judgment for special conditions. Defendant to voluntarily surrender to the Bureau of Prisons on Monday, September 16, 2024. In the meantime, Defendant will continue with pretrial supervision, as to the conditions previously ordered. Defendant requested that the Court recommend Defendant to serve sentence at FCI Lompoc. Probation to forward Defendant's medical records to the Bureau of Prisons.
