Notice of Final Order of Forfeiture

The United States of America, by undersigned counsel, respectfully advises the Court of the United States' compliance with the notice and publication requirements of 21 U.S.C. § 853(n)(1), as adopted by 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), Rule 32.2(b)(6)(C), and the provisions of the Preliminary Order of Forfeiture.

On January 4, 2022, the Court entered a Preliminary Order (Doc. 89). The order provided that the United States publish notice of the order and its intent to dispose of the property and provide direct notice to interested parties.

The United States published notice of the forfeiture on www.forfeiture.gov, beginning on January 6, 2022, through February 5, 2022 (Doc. 90). The time period for filing a petition in the ancillary proceeding has expired and no ancillary petitions were filed. Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 32.2(c)(2) on March 7, 2022, the Preliminary Order of Forfeiture became the Final Order of Forfeiture as to the following property:

1. \$170,744.05 in funds, seized from Tulsa Federal Credit Union account number xxx5999;
2. \$20,100.52 in funds, seized from Tulsa Federal Credit Union account number xxx6774;
3. \$19,146.54 in funds, seized from Tulsa Federal Credit Union account number xx7049; and
4. A \$118,678.39 money judgment.
