MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING HEARING

COMES NOW the Defendant, Alexis Ransom, by counsel, and hereby moves the Court for an Order continuing her sentencing hearing and all related pre-sentencing dates and deadlines for at least thirty days. In support thereof, Ms. Ransom states as follows:

1. Ms. Ransom's sentencing hearing is presently scheduled for December 7, 2022, at 11:00 a.m. in Charleston before the Honorable David A. Faber.

2. Ms. Ransom is pregnant and actively in labor at this time. In order to provide her with time to recover from childbirth and attend to her newborn, and to provide sufficient time for her to confer with counsel regarding the Draft PSR, any objections, and the filing of any sentencing memoranda, Ms. Ransom requests a continuance of her sentencing hearing and all related pre-sentencing dates and deadlines for at least thirty days.

3. Counsel has consulted Assistant United States Attorney Kathleen Robeson and United States Probation Officer Erin Stone, who advised that they do not oppose the relief being requested by the Defendant.

The Defendant certifies that the reasons for the request do not include general congestion of the Court's calendar, or lack of diligent preparation on the part of the parties involved.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant, Alexis Ransom, respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order continuing her sentencing hearing and all related pre-sentencing dates and deadlines for at least thirty days.
