Initial Appearance

Court advised defendants of rights. Court advised the Defendants about his/her rights to have the hearing in person. Defendants consented to the hearings being held by video conference.

Defendants sworn. Court questions the Defendants about his/her financial resources on the record and advises of his/her rights to representation. Based on the courts findings of the defendants limited resources, the Federal Public Defender is appointed for Amber Bruey and Landon Miller -CJA Counsel for Defendant Anthony Bruey. The Defendants may be required to contribute or reimburse the cost of representation at a later date based on the Court's findings. Orders to follow. Government summarized allegations and possible penalties.

Oral Orders as required by Rule 5(f), the United States is ordered to produce all exculpatory evidence to the defendant pursuant to Brady v. Maryland and its progeny. Failing to do so in a timely manner may result in sanctions, including exclusion of evidence, adverse jury instruction, dismissal of charges and contempt proceedings.

Government is requesting to adopt the removing District's bond. No objection from Defendants. Court will adopt the removing District's bonds. Defendants remain on all conditions previously imposed.

Arraignment:

Defendants pled not guilty to all Counts of the Indictment pertaining to said Defendant. Court will enter a not guilty pleas on Defendant's behalf. Scheduling orders to follow.
