PROCEEDINGS: MOTION HEARING

Court addresses motion for 90-day extension of reporting date (Doc. 144). – granted in part and denied in part..

Defendant requests BOP designation that would allow participation in the MINT program – this would allow dft to be in a half-way house while nursing (infant cannot accept formula). Government advises this program is normally reserved for defendants that give birth while in custody and not sure she will qualify.

Court grants in part and denies in part Defendant's motion (Doc. 144). Defendant is directed to self-surrender to FPC Alderson on 5/12/2023 and Court will recommend participation in the MINT program to BOP.
