Inmate Bruey: FSA Conditional Release Date is October 06, 2025.

Inmate Bruey has been individually assessed for RRC placement under the Second Chance Act using the five factor review from 18 U.S.C. 3621(b). Her individual release needs were evaluated by the Unit Team based on the five factors. 1. There are available RRC's in her release area. 2. There are no extenuating circumstances that would preclude placement. 3. She does have an established residence and community ties. Her sentence was 48 months, and she has been removed from the community for the time period. Therefore, an RRC placement date of December 27, 2024, should be an adequate amount of time for her to take full advantage of the transitional programs and services. 4. There were no statements on the J&C from the sentencing court in the Middle District of Florida regarding RRC placement at the time of sentencing. 5. There are no pertinent policies by the US Sentencing Commission. Bruey is expected earn 40 additional days of time credits towards RRC/HC placement, and the Unit Team is recommending an additional 9 months under the Second Chance Act. Therefore, a placement date of December 27, 2024, is requested. We are requesting RRC placement/HC consideration and or FLM whichever you deem appropriate.

I am writing you concerning defendant Amber Bruey.

I have known Amber for 19 months as we served our sentences together at Alderson FRC. Amber is someone who I would describe as an exceptional adult person in custody.

She has during her time here been an adult teacher's aid in the educational department teaching English as a second language and HVAC. In addition to her work as a teacher's aide Amber has taken over 25 First Step Act classes. Her impact here at Alderson has been felt as dozens of Amber's students have gone on to pass their GED exam. Students always come up to Amber casually and thank her for her care in class and the manner in which she takes her time to make sure that they understand what they are learning is invaluable. Amber aside from her work is a genuine good hearted individual. She is a great friend and mother. I thank you for your time and consideration in reading this letter.

To whom it may concern:

When Amber asked me to write a character letter for her, I could not have agreed faster than I did. She is a wonderful young woman. I came to know her much like a lot of other women her did; it was from a distance. We all knew she was going through many things, but the extent of those things were somewhat unknown to me and others.

After she settled in, she then had to begin to fight to overcome all of the obstacles that were in her way. Medical and administrative both. I have been incarcerated for 21 months at this point and I have spent much of that time working with Amber and getting to know her. Although we don't live in the same dorm (housing unit), we spent countless hours together. She became a GED tutor and we worked side by side each day. I can't begin to tell you how much this woman loves and misses her family. Her absence from the home is stressful to say the very least for her children and devastating to Amber herself. I understand that we have been convicted of a crime and are being punished, but consideration for a reduction would be an amazing thing. She works tirelessly to help the women here learn what it will take to succeed and helps them on a daily basis. Eventhough she is doing great things for these women, her time needs to be spent with her children and the rest of her family so that they have the benefit of her in the home instead of her being such a distance away.
