I'm writing this letter to you because I'm high risk pregnant in my 2nd trimester and suffering from pre-eclampsia, severe anemia, ^{hyper}tension, thyroid disease, post partum. I have a one year old, I'm caring for as well. My support system and only support is my significant other Andra Thompson who is incarcerated and serving time. I'm not from the Maryland area I relocated 5yrs ago from Boston, MA and all my family is there. We found out I was pregnant the day he went in. When he went to court and got sentenced we did not know I was pregnant. There are days I feel okay, and then there are days I can't get out of bed. It's been extremely difficult and stressful without Andra (my support for me and our child). I have to start iron infusions due to my iron being so low. This is generally 2-3x / a week for 3hrs. My last pregnancy I was put on bed rest during my third trimester. I am worried that will likely happen again due to my health and being high risk. The BOP released a letter on June 17, 2025 to maximize the availability of home confinement. When / If available we are requesting home confinement to finish out his prison term. Andra can continue serving his sentence at home to support me and our son due to my health and current status. My doctor wants me to remain stress free, worry free, and not lift over 30lbs, our 1 year old is over 30lbs. My stress level is high as I tend to worry about his current situation in prison.
