CHANGE OF PLEA HEARING

Sentencing is set for Monday, November 8, 2021, at 1:30 p.m. before the Honorable Judge R. Brooke Jackson in Courtroom A-902, Ninth Floor, Alfred A. Arraj United States Courthouse, 901 19th Street, Denver, Colorado 80294.

The defendant is remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal.
