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SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

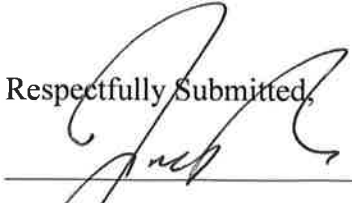
Defendant's application for reconsideration contained information regarding an affidavit for surety with justification. The application indicated that Ashot Samsonian's wife— whose name is Evelina Manukyan—was willing to sign a \$50,000 affidavit of surety with justification, full deeding her property located at: 67110 Garbino Road, Cathedral City, CA 92234. In response to the Honorable Judge Stephen Wilson's request for supplemental information, we note that the deed for the property—included as exhibit [Dkt. 355-1]—contains the name Evelina Manukyan. Evelina Manukyan is the wife of Ashot Samsonian, but Ms. Manukyan has chosen to keep her maiden name.

The Defense is respectfully requesting that the defendant be allowed to be released upon signing of an affidavit of surety without justification by Evelina Manukyan for \$50,000 in addition to complete compliance of any other orders made by the Honorable Judge Stephen Wilson. In addition, said surety will then be replaced by an affidavit of surety with justification upon the recording of the appropriate deed of trust and related documents. The reason for this request is that due to COVID, it takes a longer time to obtain appraisals and record deeds of trust with the county.
