This letter is to verify that Ms. Aticha Jittaphol was a resident of the Hope Center Clinical Stabilization Center for Substance Use Disorders. She was admitted to the Hope Center, after completion of detox at Carlson Recovery Center, on 12/13/2021 and completed to home on 12/27/2021. According to Ms. Jittaphol's P45 form, services ordered to complete were 7 days inpatient, 14 days short-term residential and 31 days (monthly) of long-term residential programing.

While a patient at Hope Center, Ms. Jittaphol continued to willingly participate in her treatment, which included psycho-education and process groups, individual sessions with her primary counselors (and other Hope Center staff), completed homework assignments, and learned new coping skills. Ms. Jittaphol also met with aftercare regarding further treatment however declined any service offered to her.
