As to the matter of detention, the United States advised the United States continues to seek detention in this matter. Counsel for the Defendant argued there are conditions that can be placed upon the Defendant to assure her appearance and the safety of the community. Counsel for the United States argued the Defendant was given multiple chances to abide by the conditions of supervised release and failed to do so.

Counsel for the United States argued the Defendant should be detained pending her appearance before Judge Stivers at the final revocation hearing.

The Court having reviewed the Petition on Supervised Release, having conferred with the Probation Officer, having heard arguments of counsel and being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED the Defendant is remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal Service pending her final revocation hearing.
