14 **MOTION TO MODIFY**
15 **PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**
16 **ORDER [Dkt. 102]**

17 The Court, having fully considered the Joint Motion to Modify the Preliminary
18 Injunction Order and having reviewed the Preliminary Injunction Order entered in
19 *Yick v. Bank of America, N.A.*, Case No. 3:21-cv-00376-VC (N.D. Cal.), ECF No.
20 103 (the “PI Order”), hereby **GRANTS** the Motion and **ORDERS** as follows:

21 The first sentence of Paragraph 7 of the PI Order is hereby deleted in its
22 entirety and replaced with the following: “Within 10 days of the entry of this Order
23 (by mail and email, if available) or after the date of the blocking (by mail, within four
24 (4) business days, and email, if available, within two (2) business days), whichever
25 is later, Defendant shall give written notice to class members whose accounts are
26 blocked solely based upon its Claims Fraud Filter that explains that the Bank will
27 promptly unblock their account if the class member authenticates their identity,

1 unless there are technology issues or delays in receiving data regarding blocked
2 accounts that prevent Defendant from meeting those deadlines, in which case
3 Defendant will give written notice by mail within five (5) business days and email,
4 if available, within three (3) business days after the date of the blocking.”
