23 *Unemployment Benefits Litigation*, No. 21-md-2992-LAB-MSB, (Dkt. 216).

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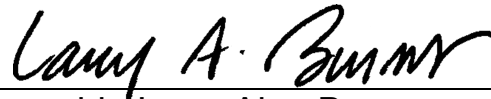
