Defendant present with counsel. Arrest date: 3/13/2026. Court summarizes the charges and potential penalties and advises Defendant of Rule 5 rights. Proceedings conducted pursuant to Rule 5(c) Todd Foster, Retained on a limited basis. Oral motion by Defendant to continue arraignment until formally retained. No objection by the government. Oral order granting oral motion to continue arraignment.	

Court continues arraignment to March 19th at 10:30am.

Defendant and defense counsel will be excused upon filing of the appropriate waiver. Defense counsel indicates that he plans to file a waiver of arraignment prior to the scheduled arraignment hearing.

Government and Defense agree to Pretrial Release conditions.

For the reasons stated on the record, court orders Defendant released with conditions.

Trial set for May 2026 trial term beginning May 4, 2026 before Judge Mizelle. Status conference on April 14th, 2026 2026.
