NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Manish S. Shah: Telephone hearing held on the motion to withdraw as counsel [27]. For the reasons stated on the record, the motion is granted. Kent Carlson is withdrawn as counsel of record, and may submit his application for payment through the CJA eVoucher system. A telephone status hearing is set for 8/13/21 at 10:00 a.m. Time is excluded until 8/13/21 under the Speedy Trial Act, without objection, to serve the ends of justice. The delay is necessary to give the parties time for effective preparation, which includes time for new counsel to familiarize herself with the case and to allow for continuity of counsel. That delay outweighs the interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. Counsel of record and other essential case participants will receive an email prior to the start of the telephone hearing with instructions to join the call.
