NEBBIA STIPULATION AND ORDER

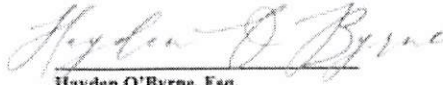
On March 29, 2021, the Honorable Jonathan Goodman, United States Magistrate Judge, set conditions of release for the Defendant, Carlos Vazquez, which included a \$50,000.00/10 percent bond with the imposition of a *Nebbia* requirement.

The parties have agreed that the funds being used to satisfy the bond are from the following source and are not illegally derived:

The \$5000.00 premium for the bond being deposited into the registry of the Court is being paid by Ms. Annabel Lee, who is the Defendant's girlfriend. The money in the form of a cashier's check was obtained from Ms. Lee's checking account at Chase Bank.
