ORDER SETTING TRIAL

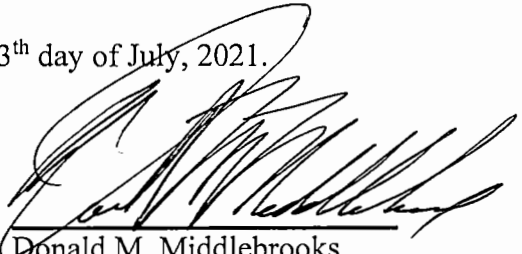
THIS CAUSE came before the court for a Change of Plea hearing on Monday, July 12, 2021. Due to the Defendant's uncertainty and reluctance to accept responsibility, the Court does not accept his plea of guilty. This case is placed back on the Court's trial calendar and the trial is set to begin on **Monday, August 2, 2021 at 9:00 am in Miami.**

Per my previous Order (D.E. 26), the Defendant was put on notice that Qualification for Acceptance of Responsibility would be jeopardized if an intention to enter a plea of guilty was not announced of record on or before July 2, 2021. Because of the reasons mentioned above, if the Defendant does not advise the Court by 2 pm on Friday, July 16, 2021 if he intends on changing his plea, the Defendant will not receive any credit for acceptance. If Defendant does intend to change his plea, defense counsel shall advise my Courtroom Deputy by 2 pm on July 16, 2021 and the plea hearing will be set the week of July 19, 2021.

For the reasons stated, the Court finds that the interests of justice outweigh the demands of the Speedy Trial Act. Therefore, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the time between July 13, 2021 and August 2, 2021 is hereby excluded from Speedy Trial Act calculations.
