Court Pronounces Judgment

It is the judgment of the Court on Count One, the defendant, Chad Brandon Thomas, is hereby committed to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons to be imprisoned for a term of **40 months**. This sentence shall be served concurrently to any sentence imposed in Wise County, Virginia, General District Court Docket Numbers GT21007204-00, GT21007204-01 and GT21007204-02, and to any sentence imposed in Sullivan County, Tennessee, General Sessions Court Docket Number 2023-RR-61987, for Violation of Order of Protection.

Upon release from imprisonment, the defendant shall be placed on supervised release for a term of **three (3) years**.
