I request an emergency compassionate release due to the incapacitation of my family members caregivers. I have provided all documentation for my children's caregivers showing they are not able to continue care for them.

My aunt, Maxine Buck, cannot care for my children due to her health conditions. Her doctor has provided written notice that caring for children is detrimental to her health.

I have already provided the information for my father and brother. Contacting them will put the safety of my children at an even greater risk. I have never known my mother.

My oldest daughter has her court hearing on December 8 and will likely be taken into state custody. All legal documentation for that has also been provided. I have exhausted all options for caregivers for my minor children. There is absolutely no one else to care for my children except me.

I have done my remedies with the Warden and the social worker at Camp Alderson. The warden along with my unit team all agree that a compassionate release is necessary for my situation due to the safety of my children. Federal probation has already approved my supervised release plan. The social worker continues to encourage me to petition the court due to the lengthy process it takes for the BOP to review cases. The remedy process is being followed but time is of the essence.

My release plan included returning home to ensure the safety and well being of my children. I will return to work. I had a working relationship with federal probation prior to my surrender and it will be the same after my release.

With the First Step Act, Second Chance Act, programming and good days, I would only be required to serve 18 months of my sentence. The 2-level point reduction and projected release dates would take an additional 10 months off of my sentence. I have already served 7 full months going into 8 months of my required time. Please take this into consideration for my compassionate release along with the safety of my 13 and 10 year old daughters.

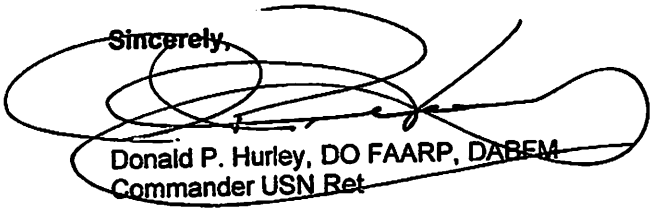

As I've stated before, I have arthritis and can not go up and down the stairs all day. When I come down in the morning, I have to have all of my meds, blood pressure cuff, insulin kit, and whatever else I may need. I have to be fully dressed also, because I wouldn't go back upstairs until time to go to bed at the end of the day.

I have 2 bad knees, I need a knee replacement on my left knee.

I've broken my right ankle in 3 places, I still have the plate, screws and pins in it, and they can not be removed because of my diabetes. So that it's difficult to walk at times my bones are weaker from chemo, and I've broken a toe on each foot, broken the side of my right foot just by stepping down the wrong way. I've also cracked the top of my right foot twice. I walk with a walker and on a cane.

So I started, I fall, I'm
so when going up or down the
stairs, stairs, someone has to
be in front and behind me.
After a while, that gets old
for children, even adults.

I had breast cancer and
had to take 5 rounds of chemo,
and 6 weeks of radiation. I
now have to take prednisone
for my bones. The side effects
are very hard on my body.
I have to see a cardiologist
and a pulmonologist.

I can't drive because of the
fact that I may have an
asthma attack and have to
use an epinephrine. I may
black out while driving.
That means whenever I have
to go somewhere, I had to call
my mother to come up to Hudson
to take me. We live at least
45 minutes away from Kora, and
my mother does not drive at
night because of night vision and
her eye.

My doctor has labeled me
disabled because of my ailments.

I have lower back problems because of an accident years ago. I have an bulging disc in my neck, I've had several surgeries, and can not walk far without stopping to sit down.

I sleep with a hip puff and have to take it with me everywhere.

I have a lot of allergies and take 2 shots every month, some I've had twice a month. I remember how bad my allergies are bothering me. I also have to take B12 shot every month. I see my oncologist and Chemotherapy every 6 months. So that means I have to leave the girls alone at night, or leave very early in the morning of my appointment.

I also take high blood pressure pills, allergy pills, hormone blocking pills, use a nebulizer (which has to be carried w/ me) when I go. I use blood thinners, inhaler, metformin and Ozempic for diabetes. I have to take glasses pills and melatonin for sleep. I take meds 3 times a day, had to check, make sure the girls eat and get ready for bed.

I then start all over the next days. This is too much for my body, especially my chest.

Above everything I've mentioned, I have a posture problem and I have to go to therapy every week.

It's hard trying to stay at Dara's house and ~~could~~ come in mine at the same time. This is the reason I had to move back home.

One more thing, Dara has carpet in her house, and it bothers my allergies, and I had to use my nebulizer more than usual and always had breathing episodes.

I hope you are reading my letter and taking this into consideration. I'm 70 years old and I am slowing down because of my ailments.

violate the criminal laws of the

in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Misprision / Misprision of a Felony (neglect in reporting a crime)

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On May 12th while in Dorchester County, the defendant, Marsha Buck, did criminally neglect to bring a felon to justice after the commission of a Murder without the defendant having previous contact or concert with or assistance of the Murder. Facts to prove the same: the defendant had knowledge a murder just occurred of a 14-year-old juvenile, allowed the offenders to stay at her residence, and did not notify law enforcement or any judicial officer. In a written statement taken after the offenders were taken into custody, the defendant detailed her knowledge of the murder. A video of the defendant using her hands like a gun while stating, "dead hoe" the day after the Murder along with a picture of an offender after he cut his hair to alter his appearance were found in her phone. A recorded interview with a witness described the defendant telling offenders they could stay at her residence because it was a predominately white neighborhood, and the cops would not look for them there.

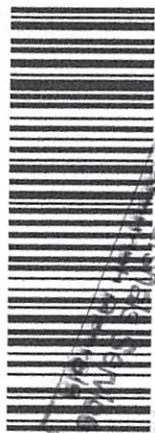
