PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS AD PROSEQUENDUM

The United States of America, by Roger B. Handberg, United States Attorney for the Middle District of Florida, states to the Court as follows:

1. An Indictment is pending in this Court against David Antonetti in the above styled case, and it is set for pre trial release violation hearing as to said defendant at Tampa, Florida, on December 16, 2024 at 2:30 pm.

FURTHERMORE, this is to command you, any United States Marshal, that upon completion of all further proceedings in this case that you return David Antonetti with all convenient speed, under safe and secure conduct to the custody of the Warden, of the Central Florida Reception.
