the offense, no violence or weapons in this offense, and I am not using controlled substances. I have no psychiatric issues. I enjoy the support of my community.

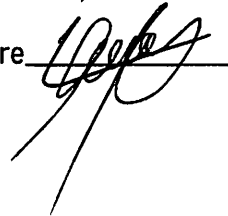
