[PROPOSED] ORDER

This matter is before the Court on Defendant's Unopposed Motion to Continue Pretrial Motion Deadline and Pretrial Conference.

Defendant's motion is **GRANTED**. The Defendant shall have until **October 11, 2021** to file any necessary pretrial motions. The pretrial conference is hereby rescheduled to _____, 2021 at _____.

The delay between the original and the rescheduled pretrial conference shall be excluded from Speedy Trial Act calculations because the Court finds that the reason for the delay is for good cause, and will allow defense counsel additional time to review the voluminous discovery and meet with his client. The Court also finds that the delay caused by the requested continuance should be excluded from Speedy Trial Act computations because the additional time is needed for adequate preparation and to prevent a miscarriage of justice and the ends of justice are

served by granting this continuance, in that they outweigh the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedy trial. See 18 U.S.C. §§ 3161(h)(7)(A), 3161(h)(7)(B)(i)&(iv).

The clerk is **DIRECTED** to exclude this time from computation under the Speedy Trial Act pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3161(h)(7)(A), 3161(h)(7)(B)(i)&(iv).
