**DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF
UNITED STATES' MOTION FOR FINAL JUDGMENT OF FORFEITURE**

I, Beverly Williams, Paralegal Specialist with the Asset Recovery Division of the United States Attorney's Office, make the following Declaration in lieu of affidavit, as permitted by 28 U.S.C. § 1746. I am aware that this Declaration will be filed with the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, and that it is the legal equivalent of a statement under oath. Accordingly, I do declare under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. This Declaration is executed by me in support of the United States' Motion for Final Judgment of Forfeiture.

2. I am a Paralegal Specialist with the Asset Recovery Division of the United States Attorney's Office. I have been employed with the United States Attorney's Office for over 44 years and as a Paralegal Specialist with the Asset Recovery Division, Asset Forfeiture section, for over 33 years. As part of my duties as the Asset Forfeiture Paralegal Specialist, I routinely send notice of forfeiture actions by FedEx and regular mail to interested third parties in order to provide them with notice of both civil and criminal forfeiture actions.
