CLERK’S MINUTES - SENTENCING

Case called; appearances made.

Oral arguments presented by the parties.

Defendant is adjudged guilty as to Counts One through Six of the Indictment.

IMPRISONMENT: 63 MONTHS. This term consists of a 63-month term as to Counts One through Six, all such terms to run concurrently.

The Court makes the following recommendation to the Bureau of Prisons:

1. Defendant be placed at a Federal Facility in Mississippi.

SUPERVISED RELEASE: 3 YEARS. This term consists of a 3-year term as to Counts One through Six, all such terms to run concurrently.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISED RELEASE:

- Financial Restrictions

- Mental Health Treatment
- Collection of DNA
- Mandatory drug testing imposed

RESTITUTION: \$739,582.50 – See Judgment for more details.

FINE: Waived.

FORFEITURE: Defendant shall forfeit to the United States those assets previously identified in the Order of Forfeiture (Doc. 247) that are subject to forfeiture.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT: \$600.00, due immediately.

Plea Agreement is accepted.

The defendant is remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal to await designation by the Bureau of Prisons.

Stand-by counsel, Mr. Nielsen's oral motion to withdraw and not be appointed as CJA counsel for appeals purposes is granted as stated on the record.

Defendant advised of right to appeal.

Court is adjourned.
