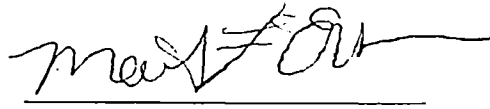

NEBBIA STIPULATION AND ORDER

On July 12, 2022, the Honorable Lisette Reid, United States Magistrate Judge, set conditions of release for Defendant Eric Dean Sheppard, which included a \$250,000 personal surety bond and a \$200,000 percentage bond, and imposed a *Nebbia* requirement. The parties have agreed that the funds being used to satisfy the percentage bond are from the following sources and are not illegally derived: The \$20,000 deposit is being paid by Jennifer L. Sheppard, Defendant's wife, from her personal bank account.
