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**SHEPPARD'S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO TRAVEL
JULY 24-27, 2025, FOR CHILD VISITATION**

1. On Friday, July 18, 2025, Sheppard transitioned to Supervised Release.
2. Today, Eric asked his assigned Probation Officer Emmanuel Aracena Santos to permit him to travel to see his 16-year-old son Jake for visiting day at summer camp in Pennsylvania; Jake has been away for more than six weeks. Officer Santos informed Eric that during the first sixty days of supervision, a court order is required for out-of-state travel.
3. Both before and after the verdict, this Court allowed such travel.
4. Visiting day at camp is next weekend. Eric proposes to travel July 24-27 with his wife Jen for this child visitation. The proposed itinerary has been provided to the government and to Officer Santos.
