ORDER

The Court on this date held a hearing on the petition for revocation of the Defendant's pretrial release. After hearing evidence proffered and legal argument from both sides, and for the reasons explained in more detail on the record in open court, the Court finds that the Defendant has violated the condition of pretrial release preventing contact with potential witnesses. The Defendant on November 9, 2020 sent text and email messages to a potential witness, and to the witness's lawyer, accusing them of asserting false claims against him, and demanding that they withdraw any claims, stop "harassing" the Defendant, and threatening to take unclear legal or other action against them if they did not comply.

As explained on the record in Court, the Court finds by clear and convincing evidence that this was a violation of the Defendant's conditions of bond and that the Defendant is not likely to abide by conditions or combination of conditions of release.

Thus, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. s. 3148(b)(1)&(2), the Court **ORDERS** the Defendant's bond **REVOKED** and that he be **DETAINED** through trial and, if applicable, sentencing.
