ORDER

Movant executed a motion to vacate his convictions and sentences pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2255 on October 20, 2023, and indicated that a “Memorandum of Law in Support will be forthcoming.” (Doc. 326). On November 1, 2023, I entered an Order instructing Movant to file that supporting memorandum within twenty days. (Doc. 328). As of February 1, 2024, Movant has not filed a supporting memorandum, which makes it impractical for the Government to respond.

Movant is directed to **SHOW CAUSE** within **FOURTEEN DAYS** of the date of this Order why this case should not be dismissed for a failure to obey an order of the Court.

The Clerk is **DIRECTED** to resubmit the matter to me upon receipt of the memorandum in support or at the expiration of the aforementioned time period.
