ORDER

After Movant filed a motion to vacate his convictions and sentences pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §2255 [Doc. 326], I entered an Order instructing the Government to show cause within thirty days why the motion should not be granted [Doc. 327]. In a letter to the Clerk, however, Movant indicated that a “Memorandum of Law in Support thereof will be forthcoming.” (Doc. 326 at 14).

Movant is **DIRECTED** to file a memorandum in support of the §2255 motion within **TWENTY** days of the date of this Order.

The Government shall have **THIRTY** days from the date Movant files the memorandum to respond thereto.

Movant is advised that a failure to file a memorandum in support within the aforementioned time period may result in dismissal of the §2255 motion.
