UNITED STATES' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE SENTENCING

The United States respectfully moves the Court to continue the sentencing hearing in the above-captioned matter for a period of one week or to the next earliest date convenient to the Court.

On April 21, 2022, this Court scheduled the sentencing hearing in this matter to occur on September 22, 2022. (Doc. 10). The undersigned Assistant United States Attorney recently learned that work-related travel will likely require his presence outside the Eastern District of Tennessee on that date. Because of unique factual issues in this case, the undersigned submits that enlisting a different Assistant United States Attorney to handle the sentencing hearing would serve neither the interests of justice, the Court, nor the defendant.

Accordingly, the United States respectfully moves the Court to continue the sentencing hearing in this matter by a period of one week (i.e., until September 29, 2022) or to the next earliest date convenient to the Court. The undersigned has consulted with defense counsel, who indicates he has no objection to the instant request.
