Dear Judge Geraghty,

I hope this letter finds you in good health and high spirits. I am writing on behalf of myself, I Harrescia Hopkins, who was ordered to self-surrender on July 28, 2023. We kindly request an extension of the self-surrender date due to medical reasons and an inability to fulfill the surrender procedures before the original deadline.

As you may be aware, Ms. Hopkins has been diagnosed with a medical

condition that requires necessary treatment and recovery. The prescribed medical procedures and subsequent rehabilitation demand additional time for her to safely transition into the custody of the appropriate authorities. Given the circumstances and understanding the importance of Ms. Hopkins' healthcare needs, we humbly request that the self-surrender date be extended to August 11, allowing her sufficient time to complete her medical treatments and adequately prepare for the surrender process.

We assure the court that Ms. Hopkins takes this matter very seriously and fully intends to cooperate with all legal proceedings. However, her current health condition necessitates a delay to ensure her well-being and the successful completion of the required medical intervention.

It is our belief that granting this extension will serve the interests of justice and fairness, while also ensuring Ms. Hopkins' health and safety. We remain committed to providing any necessary documentation or further information to support this request.

The flu is a serious, contagious illness caused by influenza viruses. Anyone can get the flu. It can cause mild to severe illness. The best way to prevent the flu is by getting a flu shot each year. The CDC and Kaiser Permanente recommend everyone 6 months and older get a flu shot every year.

3 ways for Mail Order:

- Go to kp.org/Rxrefill. After signing into kp.org, you will be brought to the Pharmacy Center.
- Use the Kaiser Permanente app for your mobile device. Find and download the app by searching for **Kaiser Permanente** on the Apple Store or the Google App Store.
- Call (800) 733-6345 and be sure to have your medical record number and the prescription number located on the medication label ready when you call. If needed, speak to an agent.
- **You must be able to wait 5-7 days before starting a new prescription.** Some medications require you to start the same day or before 5-7 days. Ask the pharmacist if you have questions.
- A credit card may be required to use the mail order option.
- Your drug benefit may allow you to order a 90-day supply of medication for a reduced copay.
- Some medications cannot be mailed due to legal or packaging requirements.

If you need to cancel your appointment, please be sure to give us at least a 24-hour notice. There will be a \$25 service charge if you do not show up for your appointment, or if you cancel the appointment less than 24 hours before the scheduled appointment.
