22 The Court has read and considered the Stipulation Regarding
23 Request for (1) Continuance of Date by Which an Indictment or
24 Information Must Be Filed, (2) Findings of Excludable Time Periods
25 Pursuant to Speedy Trial Act, and (3) Continuance of Post-Indictment
26 Arraignment filed by the parties in this matter on December 26,
27 2020. The Court hereby finds that the Stipulation, which this Court
28 incorporates by reference into this Order, demonstrates facts that

1 support a continuance of the date by which an indictment or
2 information must be filed in this matter, and provides good cause
3 for a finding of excludable time pursuant to the Speedy Trial Act,
4 18 U.S.C. § 3161.

5 The Court further finds that: (i) the arrest of defendant
6 occurred at a time such that it is unreasonable to expect return and
7 filing of an indictment within the time period specified in 18
8 U.S.C. § 3161(b); (ii) the facts upon which the grand jury must base
9 its determination are complex and, thus, it would be unreasonable to
10 expect return and filing of an indictment within the period
11 specified in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(b); and (iii) the ends of justice
12 outweigh the interest of the public and defendant in the filing of
13 an information or indictment within the original date prescribed by
14 the Speedy Trial Act.

15 THEREFORE, FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN:

16 1. The date by which an indictment or information must be
17 filed in this matter is continued from January 7, 2021, to January
18 29, 2021. Post-indictment arraignment is continued from December
19 29, 2020, at 11:30 p.m., to February 2, 2021, at 11:30 p.m.

20 2. The time period from December 9, 2020, to January 10,
21 2021, inclusive, is excluded in computing the time within which the
22 indictment or information must be filed, pursuant to 18 U.S.C.
23 § 3161(h)(7)(A).

24 3. Defendant shall appear in the duty courtroom of the Roybal
25 Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 255 East Temple
26 Street, Los Angeles, California, on February 2, 2021, at 11:30 p.m.,
27 for post-indictment arraignment.

1 4. Nothing in this Order shall preclude a finding that other
2 provisions of the Speedy Trial Act dictate that additional time
3 periods are excluded from the period within which the indictment or
4 information must be filed. Moreover, the same provisions and/or
5 other provisions of the Speedy Trial Act may in the future authorize
6 the exclusion of additional time periods from the period within
7 which the indictment or information must be filed.
