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27 The Court has read and considered the Stipulated Request for
28 (1) Continuance of Date by Which an Indictment or Information Must

1 Be Filed; (2) Findings of Excludable Time Pursuant to Speedy Trial
2 Act; and (3) Continuance of Post-Indictment Arraignment Date as to
3 defendant HASSAN KANYIKE ("defendant"), filed by the parties in this
4 matter on January 15, 2021. The Court hereby finds that the
5 Stipulation, which this Court incorporates by reference into this
6 Order, demonstrates facts that support a continuance of the date by
7 which an indictment or information must be filed in this matter, and
8 provides good cause for a finding of excludable time pursuant to the
9 Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161.

10 The Court further finds that: (i) the arrest of defendant
11 occurred at a time such that it is unreasonable to expect return and
12 filing of an indictment within the time period specified in 18
13 U.S.C. § 3161(b); (ii) the facts upon which the grand jury must base
14 its determination are complex and, thus, it would be unreasonable to
15 expect return and filing of an indictment within the period
16 specified in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(b); and (iii) the ends of justice
17 outweigh the interest of the public and defendant in the filing of
18 an information or indictment within the original date prescribed by
19 the Speedy Trial Act.

20 THEREFORE, FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN:

21 1. The date by which an indictment or information must be
22 filed in this matter is continued from January 29, 2021, to February
23 26, 2021. Defendant's Post-indictment Arraignment is continued from
24 February 2, 2021, to March 2, 2021, at 11:30 a.m.

25 2. The time period from December 9, 2020, to January 29,
26 2021, inclusive, is excluded in computing the time within which the
27 indictment or information must be filed, pursuant to 18 U.S.C.
28 §§ 3161(h)(7)(A) and (h)(B)(iii).

4. Nothing in this Order shall preclude a finding that other provisions of the Speedy Trial Act dictate that additional time periods are excluded from the period within which the indictment or information must be filed. Moreover, the same provisions and/or other provisions of the Speedy Trial Act may in the future authorize the exclusion of additional time periods from the period within which the indictment or information must be filed.
