Court sets forth background from the December 2025 hearing. Court addresses PSR and remaining objections. Government calls BENJAMIN WOOD; oath given. Direct by Mr. Storage. Gov't Ex 1 marked and admitted. Gov't Ex 2 marked and admitted. Gov't Ex 3 marked and admitted. Gov't Ex 4 marked and admitted. Gov't Ex 5 marked and admitted. Cross by Mr. Robertson. Redirect. Defendant calls BENJAMIN WOOD (already under oath). Direct by Mr. Robertson. Court makes findings regarding relevant conduct. Defendant placed under oath. Court ADOPTS findings in PSR. Probation to file PSR in court file under seal. Court makes findings re: applicable U.S.S.G. ranges. Court addresses 3553(a) factors and hears from parties re: relevant sentencing issues. Defendant speaks on her own behalf. After considering advisory U.S.S.G. ranges and 3553(a) factors, Court IMPOSES sentence as follows:
Custody: 24 months as to both counts to run concurrently
Supervised Release: 5 years (Ct 1); 3 years (Ct 2) to run concurrently
Restitution: \$184,014.04
Fine: none imposed
Assessment: \$200
Court states reasons for sentence imposed. Defendant advised of right to appeal. Defendant's motion for release pending appeal (Doc 417) is DENIED. Defendant RELEASED on prior bond to self-report.
