☒ **COURT PRONOUNCES JUDGMENT:**

The defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons to be imprisoned for a term of **66 months** as to **Counts Two and 66 months** as to **Count Eight**, as to each count, to run **concurrently**, for a net effective sentence of **66 months**. This sentence shall run **concurrently** to any sentence that may be imposed for the pending probation violations in Hawkins County, Tennessee, Criminal Court Docket Numbers CC16CR199, CC16CR200, CC16CR204, and CC16CR205. To run **consecutively** to the pending supervised release violation in United States District Court Docket Number 2:18CR00025-001. Upon release from imprisonment, the defendant shall be placed on supervised release for a term of **three (3) years**, as to each count, to run **concurrently**, for a net effective term of **three (3) years**. As to the revocation of supervision in case number 2:18-cr-25, the defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons to be imprisoned for a term of **12 months**, with no supervision to follow, to run **consecutive** to the sentence pronounced in Docket Number 2:22-CR-00052-001. The defendant shall not commit another federal, state, or local crime; shall comply with the standard conditions that have been adopted by this Court in Local Rule 83.10; and shall not illegally possess a controlled substance. The defendant shall not possess any ammunition, a firearm, destructive device or any other dangerous weapon. The defendant shall cooperate in the collection of DNA. The defendant shall comply with the special conditions set forth in the J&C.

The Court will recommend that the defendant receive 500 hours of substance abuse treatment from the Bureau of Prisons' Institute Residential Drug Abuse Treatment Program. The Court will recommend the defendant receive a physical health evaluation, and a mental health evaluation, and needed treatment while in the custody of the Bureau of Prisons. Lastly, the Court will recommend the defendant be designated to the BOP facility at Alderson, WV.
