On December 19, 2022, conditions of probation modified to require the defendant to submit to random urinalysis or an drug screening method whenever deemed appropriate by the probation officer, participate in treatment as directed by the probation officer, and not use any method or device to evade a urine screen. On July 29, 2024, conditions of probation modified to require the defendant to participate in a term of home detention with GPS monitoring for a period of 90 days.
