Dear Judge Coughenour:

In accordance with your court order dated November 25, Mr. Shibley was committed to the Federal Detention Center, SeaTac, Washington (FDC SeaTac), for a period of study to determine his mental competency.

The defendant was not designated to FDC SeaTac for his evaluation until December 17, 2020. Ordinarily, the study period begins on the date of designation. However, Mr. Shibley was not medically cleared and the assigned psychologist was on leave until January 4, 2021. Furthermore, FDC SeaTac is under modified operations, with restricted movement within the facility. These modified operations are expected to continue until further notice, and will impact our abilities to conduct and complete the evaluations under the normal time frames. We are thus unable to provide specific information as to timelines regarding completion of the evaluation and report, but will continue to provide updates to the Court.
