Honorable Judge Stivers,

My name is Mandy Ellen Bauer. On 5-17-2022 I pled guilty to Wire Fraud and was sentenced to a total term of 1 year plus 1 day. You further explained to me that because I was the first of many to appear before you in the Western District, you had to "Set the bar" with my case. Also, you gave me this Sentence because if I was a "good" inmate and had no further incidents, I would only do 4 months locked up and the last 6 months either at a half-way house or Home Confinement.

I Self-Surrendered on 6-24-2022 to FMC Satellite Camp at 3301 Leestown Road

in Lexington Kentucky. I have since then held a steady job in the kitchen and have taken and completed 19 Programs and Education classes. Earning myself many FSA Credits, Certificates and Good Time.

I have however recently learned that my time away has taken a toll on my family. Because of my absence, my spouse has had to take on an extra work load. We have a 7 year old Autistic son who has Special Needs. He has doctor appointments, school and has weekly therapy sessions. Working around his schedule is nearly impossible when doing it alone.

After losing his job, my spouse broke down telling me how "he can't do this alone." Now we are on the verge of losing our home and my family is about to become homeless.

I am writing you today as that "model Inmate". I have spent my time to the best

of my ability. Since 10-22-2022 I have been locked up 4 months. The amount of time you stated in Court that I would remain locked up.

It is at this time that I would like to ask the Courts, and also You Honorable Judge Stivers, to please grant me a Compassionate Release so that I can go home and do my part in taking care of my family.

I am asking on behalf of not only myself, but for my Son as well. I don't want to see my family become homeless because of my mistakes.
