Thank you for allowing me the opportunity to refile my motion (DN 27) for Compassionate Release. I have included with this letter a copy of a Cop-Out written by myself and sent to Mr. David Paul, the Warden of my facility. My request was sent on October 18, 2022. There has been a lapse of 30 days from the receipt of this letter and I still have not been given a response.

I come before the courts today to refile my motion and to show evidence that I have complied with the exhaustion requirements of § 3582 (c) (1) (A). Also I have held a job in the kitchen where I receive positive work reports. I have taken and completed 22 Program and Education classes earning myself many FSA Credits, Certificates and Good Credit Time.

Unfortunately my incarceration has become a burden on my family, causing financial hardship and making it difficult for my spouse to properly care for our 6 year old autistic son.

I come before you, Honorable Judge Stivers, as a Mother who has put forth effort and used my time to the best of my ability, and only after a lapse of 30 days and no response has been given to me by the warden of my facility, I am asking the courts to please grant me a compassionate release so that I can return home to my son and do my part in taking care of my family.
