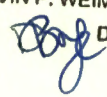

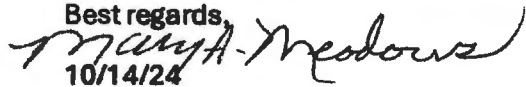

I am writing to provide a character reference for Boeroepae Jordan, who is currently on probation. I have known Boeroepae for 51 years as my only child, and as his mother, I can attest to his character, growth, and commitment.

Growing up, Boeroepae was a well-disciplined child, raised by myself and his grandmother. As a single mother, I instilled modesty in him, and he has always maintained a humble demeanor both at home and in school. He attended St. Paul of the Cross Catholic School and later The Howard School, a private institution, where he graduated as valedictorian. Following that, he pursued a degree in Pre-Law at Georgia Southern University before transitioning to American Intercontinental University to study Fashion Design and Marketing. Throughout his journey, Boeroepae has consistently demonstrated intelligence and an easy-going nature among his peers.
