ACCEPTANCE OF GUILTY PLEA AND ADJUDICATION OF GUILT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court upon the filing of a Report and Recommendation Concerning Plea of Guilty (Doc. 43) filed on June 2, 2025. United States Magistrate Judge Samuel J. Horovitz recommends that the Court accept Defendant's plea of guilty, that the Defendant be adjudicated guilty, and that the Court impose sentence at a sentencing hearing.

After an independent *de novo* review of the record and noting that the parties waived the 14-day objection period to the Report and Recommendation, this Court agrees entirely with the findings of fact and conclusions of law in the Report and Recommendation.

It is therefore **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Report and Recommendation (Doc. 43) is **ADOPTED** and **CONFIRMED** and made a part of this Order.
2. The plea is accepted.
3. Defendant is hereby adjudicated guilty as to Counts One, Six, and Eight of the Indictment (Doc. 1).

4. Sentencing for the Defendant is hereby scheduled for **September 8, 2025, at 9:30 A.M.**, before the undersigned in the United States Courthouse, Courtroom No. 12A, Twelfth Floor, 300 North Hogan Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32202.
