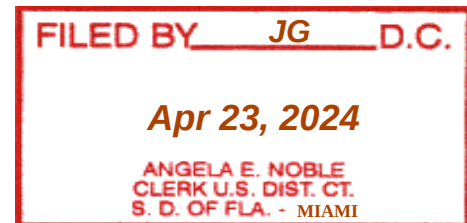

PER CURIAM:

The Government’s motion to dismiss this appeal pursuant to the appeal waiver in Appellant’s plea agreement is GRANTED. *See United States v. Bushert*, 997 F.2d 1343, 1350-51 (11th Cir. 1993) (sentence appeal waiver will be enforced if it was made knowingly and voluntarily); *United States v. Grinard-Henry*, 399 F.3d 1294, 1296 (11th Cir. 2005) (waiver of the right to appeal includes waiver of the right to appeal difficult or debatable legal issues or even blatant error); *King v. United States*, 41 F. 4th 1363, 1369 (11th Cir. 2022) (appeal waivers “account in advance for unpredicted future developments in the law” (quoting *Oliver v. United States*, 951 F.3d 841, 845 (7th Cir. 2020))).
