**ORDER APPROVING JOINT STIPULATION AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS TO
ASSUME AND ASSIGN LEASE AGREEMENT TO SUNMED GROUP HOLDINGS,
LLC (D/B/A AIRLIFE)**

Upon consideration of the *Joint Stipulation Authorizing the Debtors to Assume and Assignee Lease Agreement to SunMed Group Holdings, LLC (d/b/a AirLife)* (the “Joint Stipulation”)² a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**; and the Court having determined that the Joint Stipulation is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, their creditors, and all parties in interest; and the Court having found that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the Amended Standing Order of Reference from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, dated February 29, 2012, that venue is proper in this District pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409, and that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and it appearing that no other or further notice is required; and after due deliberation, and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor,
