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**PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR MICHAEL W. WEAVER TO
APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE*, CONSENT TO DESIGNATION, AND REQUEST
TO ELECTRONICALLY RECEIVE NOTICES OF ELECTRONIC FILING**
