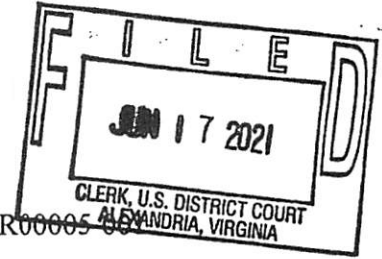

The defendant pleaded guilty to Counts 1, 2, and 3 of the Criminal Information.

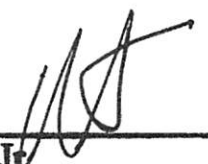
Accordingly, the defendant is adjudicated guilty of the following counts involving the indicated offenses.

As pronounced on June 16, 2021, the defendant is sentenced as provided in pages 2 through 6 of this Judgment. The sentence is imposed pursuant to the Sentencing Reform Act of 1984.

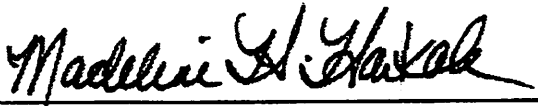

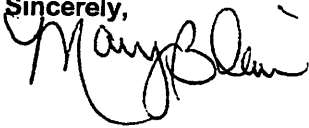

Per your request, I am providing this letter as a means of confirming you are seen in my clinic for clinical distress related to generalized anxiety and depression. As your records will show—since June 22, 2022—you have been attending individual psychotherapy sessions to develop effective coping strategies for the management of these symptoms. I strongly commend your commitment to treatment and the daily efforts you make to improve and stabilize your functioning. From our clinical interview and subsequent therapy sessions, it is my professional opinion that there is no evidence to suggest that your condition or treatment will impair your judgment and reliability. (b) the individual has voluntarily entered a counseling or treatment program for a condition that is amenable to treatment, and the individual is currently receiving counseling or treatment with a favorable prognosis by a duly qualified mental health professional;

(c) recent opinion by a duly qualified mental health professional employed by, or acceptable to and approved by, the U.S. Government that an individual's previous condition is under control or in remission, and has a low probability of recurrence or exacerbation;

(d) the past psychological/psychiatric condition was temporary, the situation has been resolved, and the individual no longer shows indications of emotional instability;

(e) there is no indication of a current problem.

GUIDELINE J: CRIMINAL CONDUCT³

30. *The Concern.* Criminal activity creates doubt about a person's judgment, reliability, and trustworthiness. By its very nature, it calls into question a person's ability or willingness to comply with laws, rules, and regulations.

31. *Conditions that could raise a security concern and may be disqualifying include:*

(a) a pattern of minor offenses, any one of which on its own would be unlikely to affect a national security eligibility decision, but which in combination cast doubt on the individual's judgment, reliability, or trustworthiness;

(b) evidence (including, but not limited to, a credible allegation, an admission, and matters of official record) of criminal conduct, regardless of whether the individual was formally charged, prosecuted, or convicted;

(c) individual is currently on parole or probation;

(d) violation or revocation of parole or probation, or failure to complete a court-mandated rehabilitation program; and

(e) discharge or dismissal from the Armed Forces for reasons less than "Honorable."

32. *Conditions that could mitigate security concerns include:*

(a) so much time has elapsed since the criminal behavior happened, or it happened under such unusual circumstances, that it is unlikely to recur and does not cast doubt on the individual's reliability, trustworthiness, or good judgment;

Dear Robert Stewart:

On behalf of the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI), I am pleased to extend to you a Conditional Offer of Employment (COE) for a Permanent appointment of Contracting Officer, General Schedule (GS) Grade 15, Step 8, with a salary of \$183,500.00 per annum.

This offer is contingent upon your successful completion of all pre-employment screening and is subject to the availability of funds. This COE may be rescinded at any time prior to your entry on duty (EOD). Accordingly, until you have been provided an EOD date by the ODNI Human Resource Management (HRM) Office, you should not take any actions based on this conditional offer.

The ODNI is committed to the highest ethical standards and, if hired as an employee, you will be covered by the criminal conflict of interest statutes and the Standards of Ethical Conduct for Employees of the Executive Branch. New employee ethics training is provided on the first day of employment but must take place no later than three months after appointment. Additionally, you may be required, depending on your position, to complete a financial disclosure report within 30 days of appointment. Summaries of the criminal conflicts of interest statutes and the Standards of Ethical Conduct can be found at [HTTPS://OGE.GOV/WEB/OGE/NSF/RESOURCES/STANDARDS-OF-CONDUCT](https://oge.gov/web/oge/NSF/RESOURCES/STANDARDS-OF-CONDUCT). You may also contact the ODNI HRM Office at (703) 275-3888 for additional information on applicable ethics requirements.

The ODNI has the responsibility to safeguard the Nation's security interests and demands high standards of conduct from employees and applicants as part of the conditions for employment. You are expected to provide complete and truthful responses on all paperwork submitted to the ODNI and during all interviews with U.S. Government personnel.

To ensure compliance with an applicable preliminary nationwide injunction, which may be supplemented, modified, or vacated, depending on the course of ongoing litigation, the ODNI will take no action to implement or enforce the COVID-19 vaccination requirement pursuant to Executive Order 14043 on Requiring Coronavirus Disease 2019 Vaccination for Federal Employees. Safer Federal Workforce Task Force guidance on other Federal agency safety protocols based on vaccination status remains in effect.

Therefore, the ODNI may request information regarding the vaccination status of selected applicants for the purpose of implementing other workplace safety protocols, such as protocols related to masking, physical distancing, testing, travel, and quarantine.

The pre-employment screening process will commence with your signed acceptance of this COE and completion of all of the enclosed forms. Please follow the instructions for completing

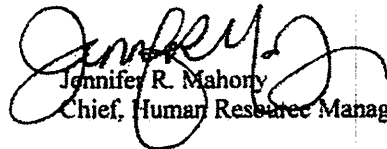
your forms, which must be received by the ODNI HRM Office no later than two weeks from the date of this letter. Additionally, if you are not a current federal employee, please send an email to the ODNI Office of General Counsel at DNI-OGC-ETHICS-TEAM@DNI.GOV. The email should include your name, the position you were selected for, and the name of your current or most recent employer. Depending on the position for which you have received a COE, you may need to complete a pre-hire conflicts check.

All ODNI employees must successfully complete a two-year trial period prior to certification as permanent cadre employees. During this trial period, supervisors will monitor factors concerning suitability that may bear on the ultimate decision regarding the retention of a new ODNI employee.

ODNI is an excepted service agency. If you will be a direct federal transfer into ODNI from a competitive service agency, by signing and returning the enclosed Accept/Decline letter, you acknowledge that you are leaving the competitive service to voluntarily accept an appointment in the excepted service.

If you have a valid reason for not being able to return promptly your package or you decide to withdraw your interest in ODNI employment, please call (703) 275-1315. We look forward to receiving your completed package so we may begin your processing.
