### ORDER OF DISMISSAL

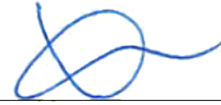
On this date, the Court considers Relator Integra Med Analytics, LLC (“Integra”), Defendant Creative Solutions in Healthcare, Inc. (“Creative”), and the United States of America’s (collectively, “the parties”) joint stipulation to dismiss this action pursuant to FED. R. CIV. PROC. 41(a)(2) (ECF No. 126), subject to the Court’s approval.

Pursuant to the stipulation and good causes appearing, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The Parties' stipulation of dismissal (ECF No. 126) is **APPROVED**.
2. This action is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** as to Relator Integra and without fees, expenses, or costs as to any party.
3. This action is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** as to the United States of America and without fees, expenses, or costs to any party.
4. Defendant Creative waives, relinquishes, and is foreclosed from pursuing any relief stemming from or related to this action, including but not limited to relief under 31 U.S.C. § 3730(d)(4) against Integra and any of its employees and agents.
5. This case is **CLOSED**.
