Ashley,

We have a few q's regarding your process:

1-NFPs: Is Kabbage set up for not-for-profits: its asking for documents like 940's or W-3 that don't apply to non profits etc.

- How do you handle parsonage?

2- It seems you use the numbers from the W3 form - Box #1 for Gross salary, Box #17 for State income Tax Withheld, Box #19 for Local tax withheld. Client: "I am quite sure that they are wrong because all three - it makes no sense. You do not add Tax Withheld to the Gross wages – its in there already. Monthly Salary Cost is calculated from Gross before it is adjusted to taxable gross which then goes to Box 1. They said I could log in again with another email address and open a new account. I am not sure what to do."

3- Several borrowers w ho were well under \$2mm previously are not being grossed up above that and becoming 'ineligible'- they think the loan amounts are too high

4- With Kabbage, we were able to pass an additional query param called "corrdata" that allowed us to track our internal lead id end to end. If we append this field to the link you provided, will that pass through in the reporting you receive?
